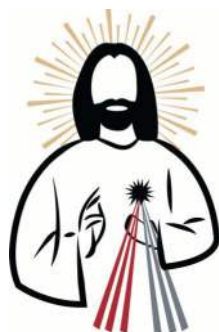

### Notice from the Cemetery

Please be advised that the mowing season is near and any objects not in accordance with cemetery rules and regulations need to be removed as soon as possible. This includes any object (statue, bench, plaque) resting on the grass. A shepherd's hook is permitted. Flowers, trees, and shrubbery may not be planted around the headstone or on the grave. Cut flowers and other decorations may be placed on the graves up to a limit of four bouquets. However, from April 1st to October 30th of each year, flowers and decorations must remain on the headstones or a shepherd's hook. We will start seeding the ground on the newly buried when the dirt has settled and weather permits.

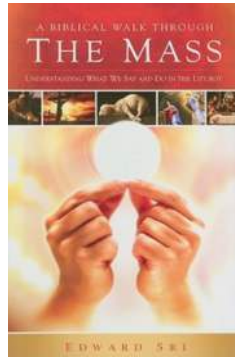

### Service and Social Justice

**Major Catholic Social Justice Documents**  
**Peace on Earth (Pacem in Terris)** This was the first encyclical to be written to "all men of good will," instead of just the world's Catholics. In it, Pope John XXIII lifts up a moral order that should prevail between humans; persons and states; and states; and in the world community. He emphasizes basic human rights and responsibilities, calls for an end to the arms race based on trust and respect for human rights, and supports the creation of a world authority to protect the universal common good. He also urges the East and West to enter into dialogue, asking them to set aside "false philosophy" in the interest of addressing important social and economic questions. John XXIII notes both that the arms race impedes the development of societies and that under-development and injustice threaten peace. He ends the encyclical with a prayer to the Prince of Peace.

We continue to take care of and nourish the poorest of poor in Honduras through our "New Life Community." We are currently in Phase II of the building mission. This phase will provide much needed water, food, electricity, sewage, and more housing to the community of Cucuyagua. In this phase, 53 additional houses will be built totaling 103 houses built! For this purpose, we are asking for your help to provide bicycles and mountain bikes of all sizes, safety helmets, and bicycle parts. The bicycles you are able to give will be a wonderful blessing to the Cucuyagua people. It will allow them to be able to ride to and from school or work everyday, rather than just walking. The bicycles provided will make it possible for individuals to cover a larger area more efficiently, allowing access to more jobs and the ability to better support their families.

Batesville Tool and Die is providing a semi trailer in the back parking lot of St. Mary Church during the weekends of May 9 & 10 and May 16 & 17 after all Masses to accept donations of bicycles, bicycle parts, and safety helmets. Any extra bicycles will go to neighbors who are in dire need. We are grateful for the support of Batesville Tool & Die. We would also like to recognize Margaret Mary Hospital, Batesville for their donation of hospital beds and medical equipment. As well as, St. Vincent de Paul, Indianapolis for donating a skid of new T-Shirts and 60 bicycles for this cause.

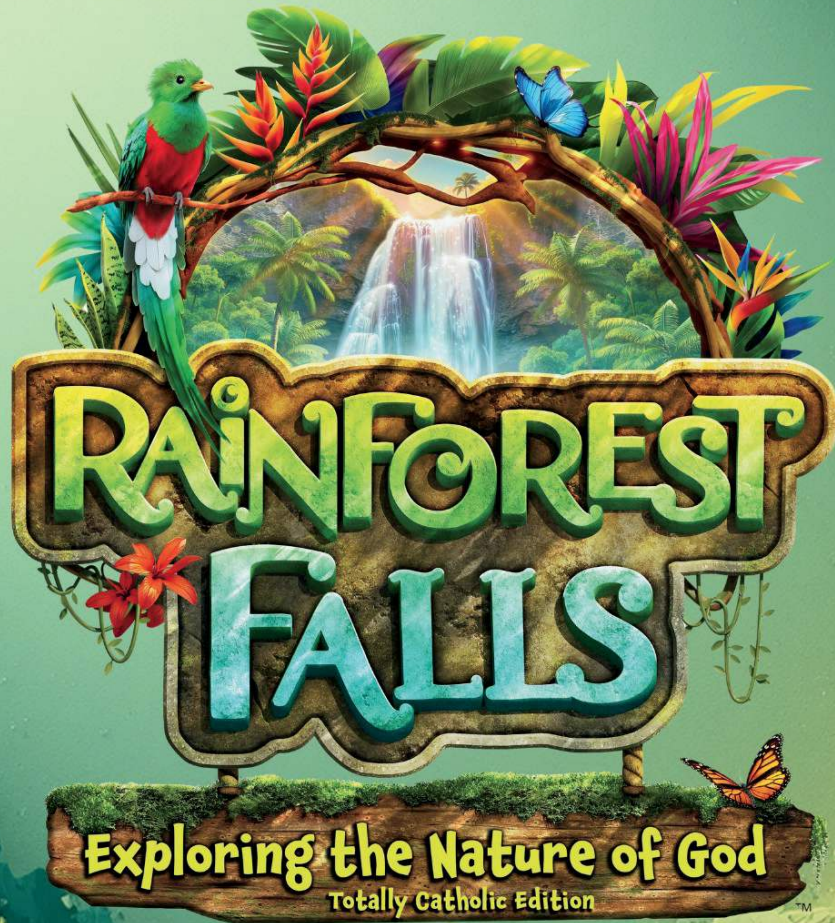
