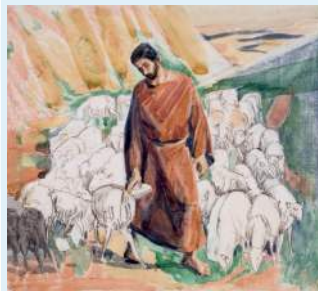

Did You Know?

There are two ways you can contribute to St. Mary online?

1. You can contribute on the St. Mary Parish Website, www.church.stmarysgreensburg.com through the online giving portal. In this portal you can setup to pay one-time, weekly, or monthly to several different contribution sources. You can use a credit card or bank account and there is a user guide to assist you through the process available on the Online giving portal. This process is completely managed by the contributor and the amount can be changed, scheduled, or suspended at any time by the parishioner.
2. The second method to contribute online is through the company, Payliance, a third party processor. This donation method requires a form to be completed and signed which is available at the Parish Office. These contributions are setup and managed by the St. Mary Business Manager, Bill Nobbe. This method allows only for ACH payments from a valid bank account. The payment can be setup one-time, weekly, or monthly and scheduled for any day of the week. Changes for this Contribution Method have to be facilitated by the Business Manager.
