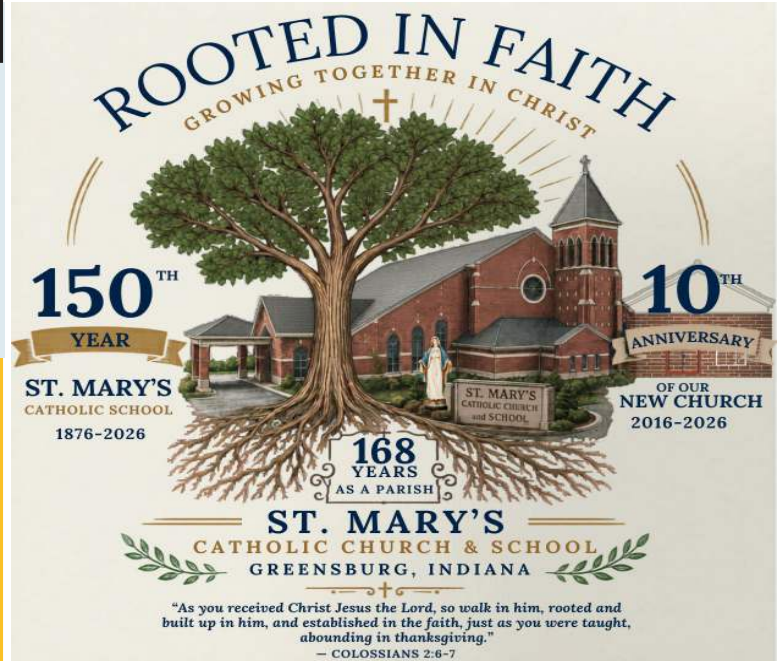

### Notice from the Cemetery

Please be advised that the mowing season is upon us and any objects not in accordance with cemetery rules and regulations need to be removed as soon as possible. This includes any object (statue, bench, plaque) resting on the grass. A shepherd's hook is permitted. Flowers, trees, and shrubbery may not be planted around the headstone or on the grave. Cut flowers and other decorations may be placed on the graves up to a limit of four bouquets. However, from April 1st to October 30th of each year, flowers and decorations must remain on the headstones or a shepherd's hook. We will start seeding the ground on the newly buried when the dirt has settled and weather permits.

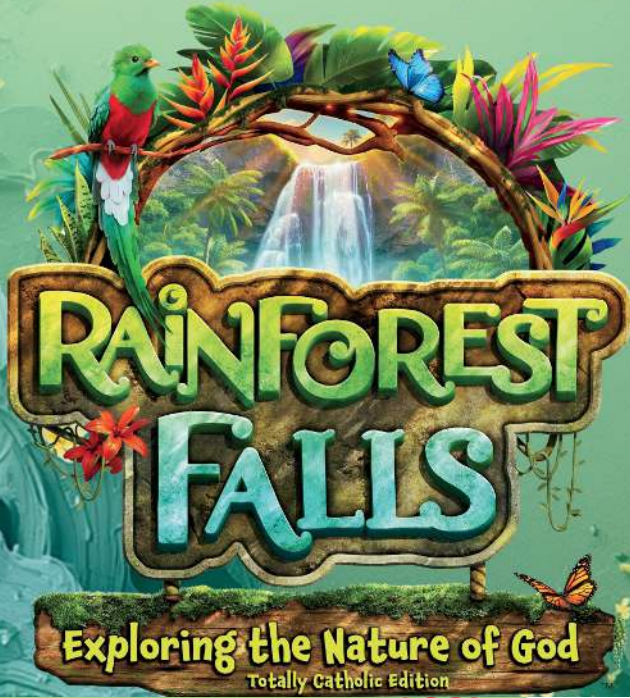

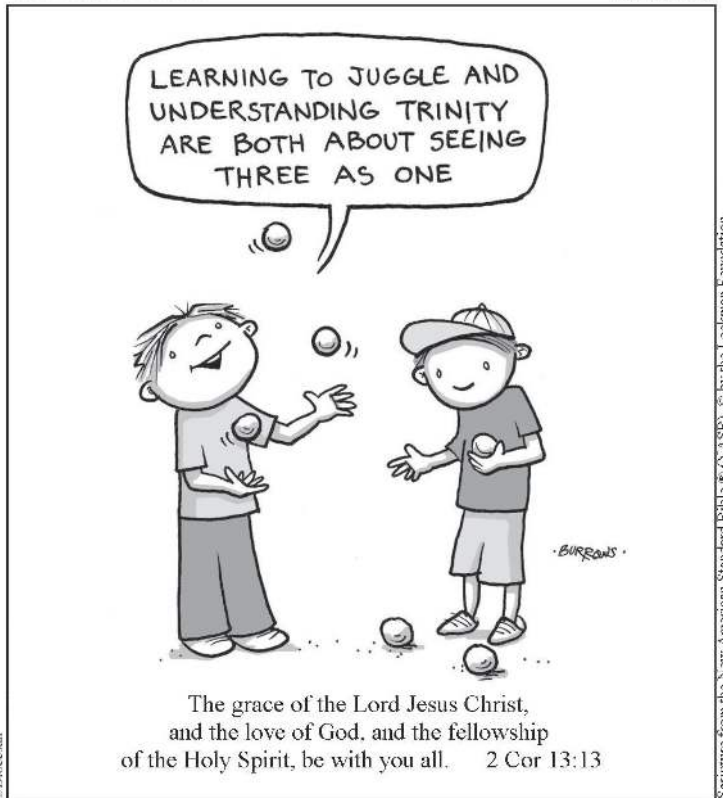
